This week the children have been enjoying the delightfully warm weather! Following our learning on bee habitats, the children enjoyed spotting bees in our garden. The children also made some bumble-bee art, using bubble wrap, tissue paper, paint and toilet rolls. As part of 'Dance with Suzanne', the children enjoyed becoming caterpillars and acting out the life cycle! In Maths, the children have been looking at the number seven, in depth. We looked at different representations of numbers and decided if each number was seven or not, using the method of 'five and some more'. The children also had a go at using their part-whole models and cubes to write equations where 'the whole' was seven.
