## Snapshot of the Week

This week, we had some very excited children as we began our topic 'Dino Detectives'! We looked at four different dinosaurs where the children thoroughly enjoyed sharing their prior knowledge. No surprises for guessing the week's most popular dinosaur... T-rex! We discussed whether he was a carnivore, omnivore or herbivore. The children also enjoyed creating some dino-art using craft paper to montage and paint.

In Maths, we spent time ordering numbers to ten, using both concrete resources and digit cards. Then we spent time comparing the size of different dinosaurs, introducing the unit of measure, metres.

Finally, we have been completing our Phonics assessments and looking at what we need to recover this half term.
