



Key Stage 2 Results - 2022

On this page you can find the following results and scores:

- the average progress score for the school in Reading, Writing and Maths
- the percentage of children who achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths
- the percentage of children who achieved a high level of attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths

How is Progress Measured?

The average progress score for each subject is zero. To calculate a child's progress in one subject, their raw score in a subject's test(s) will be converted into a 'scaled score' (from 80-120). This scaled score is compared to a bespoke predicted score for each child. The child's scaled score compared to their predicted score generates their progress score, in each subject. For each school, all children's progress scores are then averaged to generate an average progress score for each subject.
