How is Progress Measured?

The average progress score for each subject is zero. To calculate a child's progress in one subject, their raw score in a subject's tests will be converted into a 'scaled score' (from 80-120). That scaled score will be compared to the average prior attainment (starting point) in Year 2 of all of their peers who achieved similar scores at that age. This group of children will then be compared – they were grouped based on their Year 2 scores in each subject and are then compared at the end of Year 6. Depending on whether their Year 6 scaled score is higher or lower than the group's average, they will receive either a positive or negative progress score. All of Coten End's children's progress scores are then averaged; then the school subsequently is given a progress score for each subject.
