

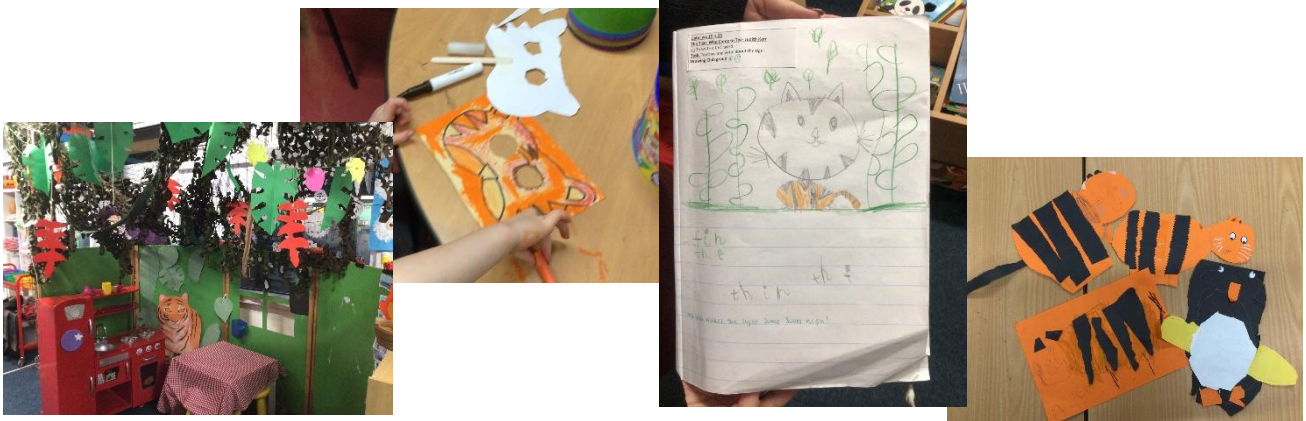
Receptions' Round Up

Snapshot of the Week

This week, we continued our learning on 'Habitat Safari' by moving onto jungle animals. We have looked at the types of animals you might find in that habitat, the various places tigers live around the world and all the wonderful array of animal skin patterns! In Drawing Club, we have read 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. We had fun planning a feast for our visiting tiger-friend and the different vehicles he might use to get to us, all the way from his natural habitat. We helped construct a jungle role play corner and made binoculars to help us spot the animals hiding in the canopy!

In Maths, we have continued to look at the numbers 1-5. This week, we focused on how we can partition five into different numbers (e.g. two and three - four and one).
