Snapshot of the Week

This week, we continued our learning on 'Habitat Safari' by further immersing ourselves in jungle life. We have focused on bears, their habitats and looked at their hibernation patterns. In Drawing Club, we have read 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. We drew bears and imagined what their caves might look like. We added to our role play corners by making paper plate parrots and caves!

In Maths, we have continued to look at the numbers 1-5. This week, we focused on Hungarian number patterns. We looked at numbers six and seven - identifying five and 'a bit more'. Then moving on to establishing how many more than five we can see.

In PE, we have been developing our gymnastics skills - learning to balance and roll.

We have continued to learn some more digraphs (oa/oo). We have also learnt our first trigraph (igh)!

We have continued to practise segmenting and blending and even started thinking about how to write a full sentence.
