

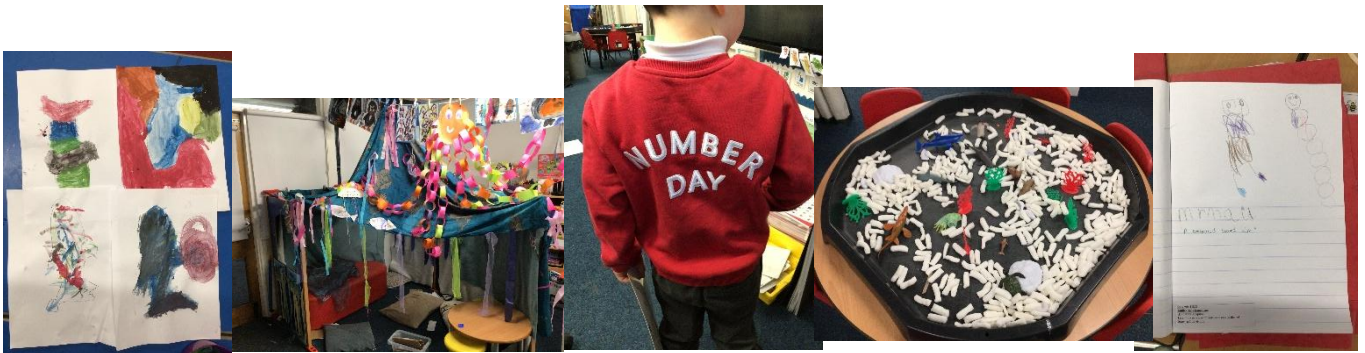
# Reception Round Up

## Snapshot of the Week

This week, we continued our learning on 'Habitat Safari' by focusing our attention on 'Under the Sea'. In Drawing Club, we read 'Tiddler'. We talked about different ways that Tiddler could escape from the net. The children drew their thoughts and used the sound card to write the caption. In our Creative area, we made jellyfish, sharks and fish collages. We collaborated to update the roleplay corners into an 'Under the sea' theme and shared octopus facts!

In Maths, we compared numbers, using key vocabulary such as 'more than', 'less than' and 'equal'. On Friday, we had a particularly great day as it was 'Number Day'! The children dressed up - their costumes containing a number and did lots of number-based activities.



## Phonics

This week, we have been revising the sounds the children have already learnt. We have spent a particular focus on the digraphs.

The digraphs taught so far are:  
/ff//ll/zz/qu/ch/th/sh/ng/ai/ee/oa/oo/.

Our taught trigraph is: /igh/.

Our Tricky Word of the week is: are.

## Ways to Help at Home

There is no homework this week so we ask that you please revise the sounds they have already been taught, paying particular attention to digraphs.

Encourage your child to use these in a phrase or sentence. Ask them, "what sounds can you hear?" It is okay if they cannot yet hear all of the sounds in the word!
