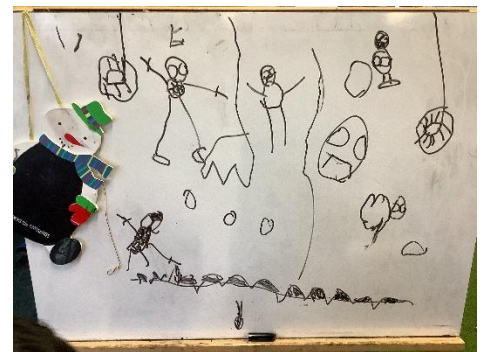
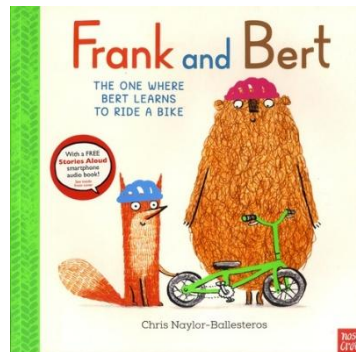
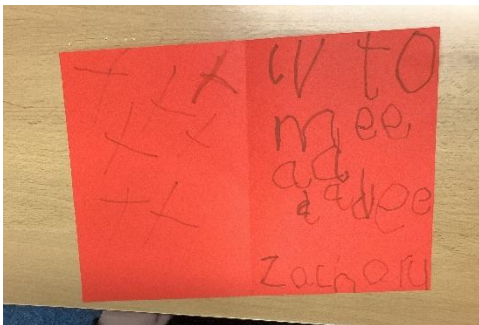


Reception Round Up
